***Accordion screens on the side of window air conditioning units often need reinforcement as cats can easily push through.** Are you willing to make appropriate enhancements if needed?

The main reason animals are returned is adopters rush the process. We work closely with adopters in the process.

29. Do you agree not to hold BTCAR responsible if the cat scratches or bites or otherwise harms a resident or guest in your home? (We work to connect foster homes with friendly, sweet kitties, but even the best of us can be cranky some days.)

30. Do you agree to pay the adoption fee: **\$225 for 1 kitten or cat and \$400 for a double adoption (2 kittens or 2 cats)**. In addition to spay/neuter, this fee helps cover the cost of rabies and FVRCP vaccinations, SNAP test (for FIV and FeLV), flea and parasite treatment, and microchipping. All fees are paid before we transfer the animal. *Kittens under 5 months are \$250/450

While all adoptions are considered foster to adopt for the first month:

adoption fees are collected at the time we transfer the animal. **This is considered a refundable deposit for the first 30 days. During this time either the rescue or the adoptee may decide it is not a good match and the animal will return to our care.** During this initial month, we stay in close contact with the adopting family, assisting with integration and with regular agreed upon check-ins and updates on the welfare of all involved and reserve the right to remove the animal if health or behavior are in decline. We will ALWAYS for the lifetime of the animals, take them back, the adoption is considered final after the first month trial period and contracts are signed.
